Reporting directly to the UK Project Lead, responsibilities will include:

- Undertaking tasks as defined in the Planned Preventative Maintenance System
- Identifying and rectify equipment and/or plant electrical failures
- Installation of new or existing equipment and plant
- Ensuring that site electrical systems, equipment and supplies are well maintained and performing as required
- Documenting changes made to electrical systems to coordination with site engineers
- Developing documentation for wiring systems where they do not exist
- Carrying out the installation and maintenance of office buildings and outbuildings
- Controlling and monitoring electrical spares stocks
- Involvement in projects to develop and improve existing processes and systems
- Championing electrical safety within a hazardous industry
- Supervising electrical contractors where required, assisting and ensuring work is delivered the standard expected
- Inspecting and maintaining equipment within an ATEX/DSEAR environment
- Maintaining 3-phase motors and control gear
- Fault finding within relay logic panels and knowledge of PLC operation
- Putting forward improvement recommendations to plant, equipment and working practices where identified
