We are seeking an **EC&I Technician** to join our friendly and motivated Maintenance Team based from our **Aldermaston** site located in the Berkshire area.

Are you looking for an exciting and challenging opportunity? Do you have a hands on and collaborative approach? Do you thrive working as a team?

Main duties/responsibilities of the role include:

This is a mobile role, covering a group of sites (located within daily commuting distance) across the Pipeline System Network. You will be responsible for the day to day EC&I maintenance and testing on the Pipeline System, working safely and methodically to ensure that all facilities, plant and equipment are maintained in an efficient working manner. Liaising with technical authorities you will provide resolution of defects, changes in the operation of specific plant items and information in response to a maintenance alert. You will also be accountable for updating computer maintenance management system (CMMS). In addition, you will carry out regular inspection and testing of SIL/SIF systems and hazardous area equipment in accordance with procedures.

Qualification/Skills:

You will have a relevant apprenticeship or associated qualifications, including those associated with Safety Management and controlling maintenance activity on an Upper Tier COMAH Site and ideally be COMPEX qualified . With experience within the oil and gas or chemical industry or a similarly regulated industry and in a similar role and including experience working on a COMAH Upper Tier site, you will also possess good attention to detail and a positive attitude.

Due to the nature of our business and this role you will participate to a “call-out “rota and need to be available for overtime when required for emergencies, hold a clean driving licence and be available to work at multiple sites within the Aldermaston area as required.

Ideally, you will have the following experience:

- Maintenance of process equipment (i.e. motor, pumps, valves)
- General Industrial Maintenance and Installation
- Calibration of Instrumentation and associated loops
- HV switching
- COMPEX qualified
- Conducting condition monitoring
