The Opportunity

Beckton Combined Heat & intelligent Power Plant is located in south-east London. It's fuelled by bio-liquids powering a MAN B&W marine 2 stroke diesel engine coupled to a 13 MW generator. Exhaust gases drive a turbo generator feeding the local LV site distribution system, before being treated through a Selective Catalytic Reduction (SCR) system, then released to atmosphere.

As we expand and optimise our plant operations, we're recruiting for a Plant Assistant to join our multi-skilled Beckton team and complete a range of operational support duties including co-ordinating tanker movements, completing fuel testing and discharge and supporting others in completing responsibilities.
